

City of Ann Arbor 2008 – 2013 Park Maintenance and Capital Improvements Millage Status: For Fiscal Years 2008 and 2009

City of Ann Arbor voters approved a six-year park millage in November 2006 that funds current, ongoing improvements to Ann Arbor's park system, which consists of 162 parks spanning 2,095.05 acres. The table below lists park development, maintenance and improvement projects funded through your support of this millage; the fiscal year (FY) in which the improvement occurred is indicated. Also indicated on this table are park improvements made possible through other funding sources, as specified.
