Summit Park Named Best

Summit Park, Ann Arbor, Michigan, has been selected to receive the National Honor Award in the 1981 Professional Grounds Management Society Awards Program, for the Best Maintained Park and Recreation Area. This is the second highest award in the national program.

Summit Park, 1.32 acres, is one of 104 park sites maintained by the City of Ann Arbor and receives over 50,000 visits annually. The award cites the consistently high quality of park maintenance which has accommodated intensive urban park use, resulting in community support for other park rehabilitations.

Summit Park features play apparatus, basketball court, picnic shelter and rest-rooms, rollerskating/jogging tracks, natural ice rink and attractive landscaping.
