




## **Furstenberg Nature Area**

Furstenberg is a 38-acre natural area bordered by the Huron River and Fuller Road. Gallup Park is just to the southeast, with a boardwalk connecting the two. Due to the variety of different ecosystem found in this park, Furstenberg features the most diverse flora of any park in Ann Arbor.
