

Sylvan Park

This park walk, located near one of the busiest areas of Southeast Ann Arbor, offers a mix of structured play spaces and nature exploration in the northern parcel of the park. Swift Run creek divides the Eastern portion hosting a 5-acre oak hickory forest with a foot path and the Western portion providing a playground and tennis court. There is also a picnic hill! A short ½ mile loop will expose you to the whole park, but please spend time doing more than just walking. There is a tennis court and playground and green space perfect for a picnic. This park highlights the necessity of green spaces for the human spirit in a busy urban area.
