

# Summer camp for young women

Blaze & Blue camp is a free, hands-on program for young women 13-18 years of age. Participants will experience the most challenging and exciting tasks in firefighting, first response and law enforcement in a supportive, educational and interactive environment.

The 2022 program will be held Monday, June 27 through Thursday, June 30. Students will train with Ann Arbor firefighters Monday/Tuesday and Ann Arbor police staff Wednesday/Thursday, 8 a.m.-3 p.m. The camp also provides access to the women that work in these roles who are breaking down barriers and stereotypes in these non-traditional career fields. Registration will be open March 7-18.
