NOTICE: Final Plan Revision for Traffic Calming on Fulmer St (Miller Ave to Foss St)

Dear Fulmer St Resident/Owner,

Thank you for your participation and involvement in the Fulmer St Traffic Calming Project. The final plan was approved in August 2023.

Due to the technical challenges installing raised crosswalks, the final plan for traffic calming on **Fulmer St from Miller Ave to Foss St** has been slightly revised, see reverse for revised plan. The following two (2) devices have been modified:

Device 2 – Raised Crosswalk will become a speed hump which will be located just north of the crosswalk.

Device 3 – Raised Crosswalk will become a speed hump which will be located just south of the proposed crosswalk.

Why did the revision(s) occur?

It's the citys repsonsibility to make sure all crosswalks are compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Due to the geometry of Fulmer St it is unachievable to install the raised crosswalk in a manner that would reduce speed and be American with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant.

Who was part of this decision?

Transportation Engineers, the Transportation Manager, and experts in construction inspection have been working hard to try and determine a feasble plan to install the device as originally approved. However, the decision to make these changes was made after a field visit was conducted and it was determined modifications were warranted to achieve speed management as well as ADA accessibility.

When will devices be installed?

Construction of these devises are anticipated to be completed this construction season. Devices will be installed in phases to minimize the impacts to residents. Notices will be delivered when a date is determined.

What are the temporary impacts to residents during construction?

- 1) On-street parking will be temporarily resitricted at identified locations within the project area.
- 2) Closures to one lane on Fulmer St, within the project area, will occur. Please adhear to all parking restrictions and signage during construction to ensure the project can be completed in a safe and timely manner.

Will the requested crosswalk still be installed?

Yes, the crosswalk request was processed and will be scheduled for installation at the requested location, as part of the Sidewalk Program. The location requested was at the enterance/exit of the path and across from 1757 Fulmer St. The installation will not happen in conjuction with the installation of traffic calming devices due to a conflicting project in the Cresents neighborhood.
