Pavement Condition/Quality

Poor (awful) condition of the road surface.

Avoid current issues on Earhart: 1. Lack of maintenance of sidewalks (mowing, shrubbery trimming) 2. Noise from road surface. 3. Frequent road use by trucks over weight limit.

Pedestrian Safety

More sidewalks would help -- e.g., on both sides of Earhart Road

Potential flashing lights at crosswalks

Accommodate street crossing for students walking to King School. From St. Paul's School to Greenhills condos, traffic often drives above speed limit.

Vegetation Maintenance

Avoid current issues on Earhart: 1. Lack of maintenance of sidewalks (mowing, shrubbery trimming) 2. Noise from road surface. 3. Frequent road use by trucks over weight limit.

Traffic Volumes/Capacity

Accommodate in/egress to/from new subdivision during rush hour when traffic is already backed up from Geddes roundabout.

Passing lane by St. Paul Lutheran School would be helpful

Transit Opportunities

Add city bus service to Earhart Road: bus pull-over spots.
