1. Changes in the Contract Documents

Changes in the Contract Documents which are outlined below are referenced to a page or in which they appear conspicuously. The bidder is to take note in its review of the documents and include these changes as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

PAGE(S) **CHANGE**

Replace BF-1 of the Contract documents with page BF-1-R1, which is included BF-1-R1 in this addendum.

> Contract Pay Item No. 206, "Remove HMA Pavement", changed Estimated Quantity from "3500" to "470".

2. Questions and Answers

Q: What is the Engineer's estimate for this project?

A: \$70,555

Q: If concrete curb and gutter removal / replacement is required to install the sanitary sewer (main line), would it be included in Pay Item # 305?

A: No, Items 208 & 210 would cover concrete curb and gutter removal and replacement, respectively.

Q: Are we to perform the standard City of Ann Arbor sanitary sewer testing?

A: Yes.

Q: Do we need to wait 30 days to perform the TV and mandrel testing?

A: The sanitary sewer will need to be tested in accordance with the City's Standard Specifications, including an air test, a 30-day mandrel test and a televised inspection.

Q: Based on the project schedule, can it be assumed that the sanitary sewer trench must be paved AFTER all sanitary testing has been completed?

A: The final HMA patch for the sanitary sewer will not be approved until the sewer has passed the required testing in accordance with the City of Ann Arbor Public Services Department Standard Specification.

Q: Are we required to connect to the existing sanitary sewer lead to 2250 Belmont during this project?

A: No. The Contractor is only required to construct the new lead to the right-of-way.
