#### **I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Respondents are directed to take note in its review of the documents of the following questions and City responses as they affect work or details in other areas not specifically referenced here.

The following Questions have been received by the City. Responses are being provided in accordance with the terms of the ITB.

**Question #1:**

I know you receive deliveries in bulk tanker trucks, but could you tell me how frequently you receive deliveries? Also, who is your current supplier and what pricing are the offering?

**Answer #1:**

We get most polymer deliveries from approximately Dec 1 thru May 1. The frequency is about every 1.5-2 months during this period. We use polymer year round but the dewatering season where we use the most is the Dec thru May period. Currently we use SNF polydyne and the cost is \$1.15/pound delivered and unloaded at our site.
