

Outdoor Grilling Code Requirements

The fire code prohibits the following, in relation to outdoor cooking and grilling:

- Charcoal burners and other open-flame cooking devices shall not be operated on combustible balconies or within 10 feet of combustible construction. Exceptions:
 - 1. One- and two-family dwellings.
 - 2. Where decks are protected by an automatic sprinkler system.
- Propane and other LPG gas burners with a liquid capacity greater than 2.5 pounds shall not be located on combustible balconies or with 10 feet of combustible construction. Exceptions:
 - 1. One- and two-family dwellings.

PROHIBITED on combustible balconies without sprinklers:







2. Charcoal kettle grills



3. Propane grills greater than 2.5 pounds water weight (1 pound gas)

ALLOWED on combustible balconies without sprinklers:





1. Electric grills



2. Portable gas grills with less than 2.5 pounds water weight (1 pound gas)
