The Ann Arbor Housing Commission is proposing to rezone 415 W. Washington as part of a pre-entitlement process, directed by City Council, to allow for a development that integrates a new segment of the treeline trail, and redevelop a portion of the site primarily as residential, with development standards that reflect the D2 Downtown Interface Zoning District. In-line with previous community engagement, the site concept is intended to preserve the Chimney Swift Habitat, engage the treeline trail, fit in with existing adjacent buildings and setbacks, provide adequate buffers to adjacent single family housing and remediate potential environmental contaminations.
