


CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEE (CAC) MEMBERS WILL...



- operate under the rules of a Charter and commit to engaging in the entire process.
- provide feedback, from a community perspective, on the Master Plan development including the scope, content, direction and recommendations of the plan
- provide guidance on the best approaches for engaging stakeholder groups and the broader public over the course of the project.
- consist of individuals who represent a broad spectrum of interests related to the Allen Creek Greenway Master Plan.
- be selected from identified stakeholders with a balance of viewpoints and from those who show an interest in participating during the project initiation phase.
- serve from the spring of 2016 through the fall of 2017
- meet six times during the project at important milestones. All meetings will be open to the public with time on the agenda for public comment.

STAKEHOLDER MEMBERS WILL...



- consist of identified groups with a vested interest and knowledge to share about the Master Plan study area.
- include representation from residential neighborhood groups; agencies/public groups; non-profit groups/environmental organizations; business organizations/commercial neighborhoods; ad-hoc organizations/grassroots
- meet in a small group format during the project at important milestones. All meetings will be open to the public with time on the agenda for public comment.

PUBLIC/COMMUNITY MEMBERS WILL...



- consist of any and all city residents, stakeholders and others interested in the Allen Creek Greenway Master Plan process.
- provide feedback in a public meeting format.
- observe and comment at CAC and Stakeholder meetings during the beginning and/or end of meetings.
- participate at three city-wide meetings at important project milestones. All meetings will be open to the public with time on the agenda for public comment.
