






















## **Lowest evaluations**







9 of the 28 photos received the highest evaluations. They included the following characteristics.

- Consistently, the highest rated photo was Bhadra Fort Park, India, which includes a balance of fountain, prominent sculpture, grassy and paved areas, trees, and lots of seating.
- All of the photos showed integral paved walkways.
- 5 of the 9 spaces had prominent trees.
- 3 of the 4 most highly rated photos had a prominent water feature—generally a fountain. The others did not have a water feature.
- Half had prominent areas for sitting; the others did not. Generally, there was significant variation in the favored photos. 3 of the 28 photos received the lowest evaluations.

My interpretation of what respondents did not favor in these photos was the following.

- No need for adult active sports, such as ping-pong.
- A memorial feature would be too passive for our space. Don't let architecture overpower the public space.
