

STREET CLOSURE INFORMATION FOR UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN HOME FOOTBALL GAMES AND OTHER DESIGNATED STADIUM EVENTS

Attention neighbors,

The Ann Arbor Police Department wants to make you aware of street closures that will be in place for the Saturday, Aug. 2, 2014, International Champions Cup soccer event as well as every University of Michigan home football game and the Oct. 18 Slippery Rock vs. Mercyhurst football game at U-M stadium.

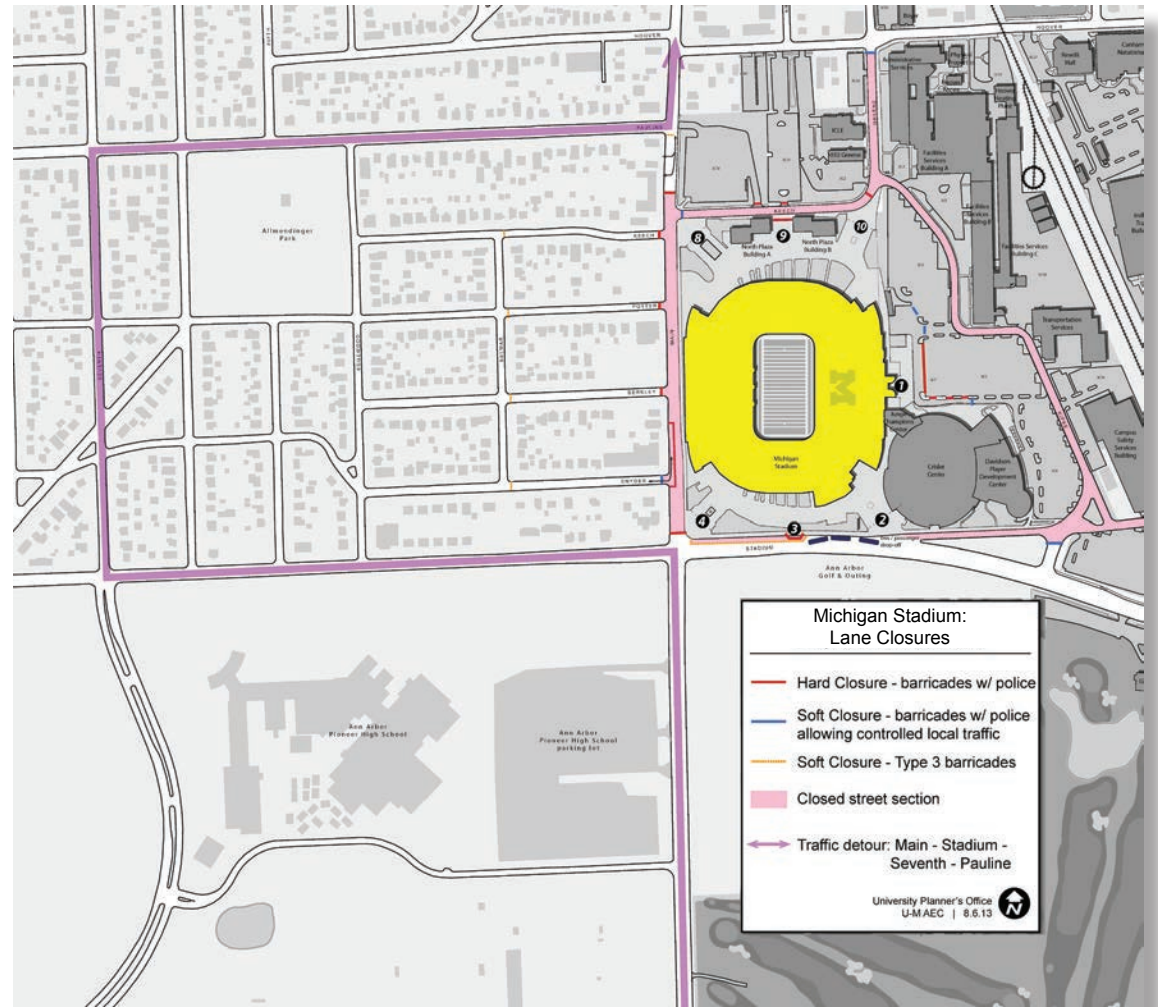
University of Michigan home football games will be held on: Aug. 30, Sept. 13, Sept. 20, Sept. 27, Oct. 11, Oct. 18 (Slippery Rock vs. Mercyhurst), Nov. 1 and Nov. 22. The street closures are part of an effort to increase safety by creating a vehicle-free zone around the stadium. It involves a cooperative effort with the University of Michigan, U.S. Department of Homeland Security and the City of Ann Arbor Police Department.

Scheduled lane closures include:

- South Main Street between Pauline and Stadium
- East Keech Street between South Main and Greene streets, limiting access to parking permit holders on Greene Street from East Hoover to Keech streets
- The westbound right-turn lane on East Stadium Boulevard (onto South Main Street) just south of the Michigan stadium

The duration of these closures will be three hours prior to each game until the end of each game, with the **exception** of southbound South Main Street, which will be closed one hour prior to the game until the end of each game.

Please note: On-street parking restrictions will be in effect on U-M home football game days and other stadium events as indicated per City Council resolution. For details, please visit www.a2gov.org/parking.
